- Performs medical tests, including, but not limited to, vital signs and electrocardiograms
- Administers investigational medications and performs patient assessments during clinic visits to determine presence of side effects; notifies Principle Investigator of findings/issues
- Provides patient education and medical information to study patients to ensure understanding of proper medication dosage, administration, and disease treatment
- Documents medical data in patient chart to capture protocol requirements

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- Maintain high standards of data management and source documentation

Required Knowledge, Experience and Technical Skills:

- Requires at least 5 years Research Nurse experience for some roles / 5 years Nursing experience for Nurses new to research (training and mentoring will be provided)

- Nursing competency skills per scope of practice (i.e., performing vital signs, nursing assessments, performing ECG, administering injections, etc.)
